We are so proud of all of our staff, who help patients like Al, and who also support patients’ families during one of the most difficult periods of their lives.

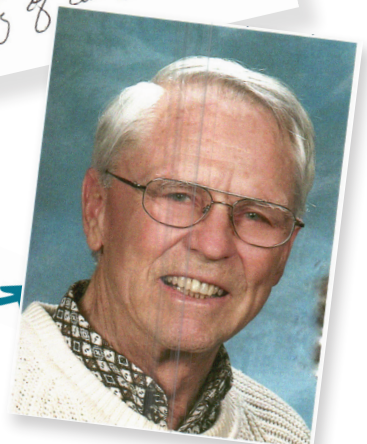
